


### **Team Up Together!** (Grades K-2 | Grades 3-6)

TEAM UP TOGETHER! promises to engage our school audiences in important ways, helping children develop strategies for what to do in difficult interpersonal interactions, as well as to embrace the the importance of working together in order to experience success.

#### TRIGGERED (Grades 7–12)



This one-man show, deals with our nation's growing drug and alcohol epidemic through the first-hand account of a recovering addict and alcoholic.

TIGER's new Assistant Director, Michael Stoddard, portrays over 25 different characters in this 45-minute production. Michael helps audiences better understand the devastating consequences faced by both the addict and the people around them who care. TRIGGERED also gives audiences important wisdom based on true experiences, to help keep young people from the ravages of addiction. (This production can be adapted to match the developmental level of the audience. A question-and-answer period is also available following the performance, if requested by the school and time permits.)



Interactive **E-LEARNING PROGRAM** (Grades K-5)

Engages, educates, and entertains students while teaching them we can get through **ANYTHING** if we work together.

TURBO TIGER is designed for educators and students to utilize both inside and outside the traditional classroom. You may release modules to teachers to supplement SEL curriculum one at a time, throughout the year or all at once, as you see fit.

# **About TIGER**

TIGER (Theatre Integrating Guidance, **Education, and Responsibility)** is a powerful and exciting collaboration between the Integrated Arts, School Psychology, and Counselor Education Graduate Programs at Plymouth State University. A professional educational theatre company, **TIGER** helps children, schools, parents, and communities deal positively with bullying and other social issues and concerns facing youth in schools today.

Based on the anonymous writings and stories of children and youth, **TIGER** performances incorporate live actors, theatre, dance, and music to engage school audiences from K-12 in a 45-minute assembly-length production. Following in the tradition of PSU's award-winning ETC (Educational Theatre Collaborative), TIGER offers the very best in theatre for all ages. A TIGER performance seeks to transform thoughts, feelings, and behavior to help both children and young adults envision and understand their own power in resolving difficult issues.

In addition to performances, **TIGER** also offers professional development (taught by Plymouth State University faculty) for teachers and parents, as well as engaging student workshops in individual classrooms following performances. Our workshops seek to promote social-emotional learning and 21st-century learning skills such as creativity, critical thinking, collaboration, and communication.

**TIGER** has performed at the state level for the New Hampshire Department of Education, regionally for the New England Theatre Conference (NETC), and nationally for the American Alliance for Theatre and Education (AATE). Internationally, **TIGER** has also performed for the National Drama International Conference at Durham University in Durham, England, the International Festival of Children's Theatre (ASSITEI) in Cairo, Egypt, and at the 2013 IDEA World Congress in Paris, France.
